- 2) Complete 6 hours of Portuguese / culture/literature courses taught in English or Portuguese.
- 3) Complete 9 hours in residence at MU. Students may be permitted to count up to 6 hours toward the minor from an officially sanctioned semester, year-long, or summer study abroad programs in Portugal or Brazil, as approved by the minor advisor.
- 4) Complete course work with a grade in the C range or higher in each of the required courses and you must maintain a 2.0 GPA in the minor.
